<sup>5</sup> "If you have raced with men on foot and they have worn you out, **how can you compete with horses?** If you stumble in safe country, how will you manage in the thickets by the Jordan?"

## II. Creation is the Beginning

Genesis 1:1-5 (NIV)

<sup>1</sup> **In the beginning God created** the heavens and the earth. <sup>2</sup> Now the earth was formless and empty, darkness was over the surface of the deep, and the Spirit of God was hovering over the waters. <sup>3</sup> And God said, "Let there be light," and there was light. <sup>4</sup> God saw that the light was good, and he separated the light from the darkness. <sup>5</sup> God called the light "day," and the darkness he called "night." And there was evening, and there was morning--the first day.

Genesis 1:27-31 (NIV)

<sup>27</sup> **So God created man in his own image, in the image of God he created him; male and female he created them.** <sup>28</sup> God blessed them and said to them, "Be fruitful and increase in number; fill the earth and subdue it. Rule over the fish of the sea and the birds of the air and over every living creature that moves on the ground . . . <sup>31</sup> God saw all that he had made, and it was very good. And there was evening, and there was morning--the sixth day.

Psalms 33:6-9 (NASB)

<sup>6</sup> **By the word of the Lord the heavens were made, And by the breath of His mouth all their host.** <sup>7</sup> He gathers the waters of the sea together as a heap; He lays up the deeps in storehouses. <sup>8</sup> Let all the earth fear the Lord; Let all the inhabitants of the world stand in awe of Him. <sup>9</sup> **For He spoke, and it was done; He commanded, and it stood fast.**

Isaiah 40:28-31 (NIV)

<sup>28</sup> Do you not know? Have you not heard? **The Lord is the everlasting God, the Creator of the ends of the earth.** He will not grow tired or weary, and his understanding no one can fathom. <sup>29</sup> He gives strength to the weary and increases the power of the weak. <sup>30</sup> Even youths grow tired and weary, and young men stumble and fall; <sup>31</sup> but those who hope in the Lord will renew their strength. They will soar on wings like eagles; they will run and not grow weary, they will walk and not be faint.
